Last April, while I was on route to the Winter Retreat, I received word that the retreat was cancelled, due to a suicide in the community. When the retreat was rescheduled and went ahead, it turned out to be a really good bonding time with the youth, and there were some very good conversations centered around Jesus, the good news about Him, and what it looks like to follow Him. One of the staff members was sharing with me how deeply affected a camper was affected by the suicide, and how it led to a long conversation and the camper nearly accepting Christ. You can pray for that camper. As nasty as the situation leading up to the retreat was, hearts were open more than usual, and some good progress was made!

My hope is that this openness will continue, and that we can capitalize on it as we continue to share Jesus with the campers. Please pray for us as a camp--that God's kingdom will be built, and that we will have the staff to make it happen. Currently, we are in need of counsellors, cooks, a lifeguard, and maintenance staff. If you know of someone that would be a good fit, or would like to come yourself, get in touch with me!"
